- When the disciples asked Jesus to teach them to pray he started that prayer with Our Father, because as believers we can call God our Father.
- Think of the parable of the lost son Luke 15
- This son was so far removed from his father that he no longer felt he could be called a son but rather a servant.
- However the father had a totally different understanding. His was one of love for his son no matter what. Yes the son had walked away from the fathers house and presence. Yes the son had squandered his inheritance however the fathers love remained the same.
- Today because of our heavenly Father's love. 2 Corinthians 5 v 19/21 God was recondling
 the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them....
- The first Adam was banished from the garden the second Adam Jesus Christ rose from the grave the victor over dead and the power of our sin.
- Adam's expulsion from the garden meant a separation between God and man. No longer was he able to enjoy the presence of the Lord like he and Eve did prior to the sin.
- However God the Father's heart was always a desire to return to that place of communion,
