DEVOTIONAL MESSAGE

The God who refines is ... by Billy

READ MALACHI 3:1-6

- The prophet Malachi was delivering a message of rebuke to God's priests because they were guilty of presenting third rate offerings to God. (1:7-8).
- God also rebuked the priest for his treachery against the wife of his youth in seeking to divorce her. (2:14).
- These priests were covering the altar with tears wondering why God hadn't answered their prayers or accepted their offerings.
- Now God's immediate purpose was not to reject such priests but to refine them.
- In so many ways we are also in need of much refining because of original sin.
- The main point is that the priests were complaining about a sense of separation from God but the genuineness of their longing for God would be tested.
- We sometimes pray for revival but are we ready for the refining process?
- Sin will have to be burned out by painful means. Stains will need to be washed away using an irritating agent.
- The only ones who can stand before Him are those who will cast themselves upon His mercy and plead the forgiveness of the cross.
- "If You Lord should mark iniquities, O Lord who could stand? But there is forgiveness with You that You may be feared." (Psa.130:3-4)
