Possession Our Possessions—Obadiah 1:17...By Gareth

READ 1 CORINTHIANS. 12: 4-31

- Od has given everything in His son Jesus Christ. However we can sometimes remain without because we fail to claim what is rightfully ours in Christ Jesus.
- I am not talking about material possessions, where some have resorted to naming and claiming, but rather the spiritual gifts that are available to us. The apostle Paul encouraged the church to earnestly desire these gifts.
- Jesus has NOT left us as orphans. He promised that in John 14:18. He didn't leave us high and dry, saved and sure but on our own telling us to do the best we can until he comes back.
- The story is told of a poor lady who lived in poverty with her son in a small flat. Her son managed to earn enough money to pay his way to America so that he could make a living for himself. Every week he would write a letter to his mother and post it along with 2 dollars. Every time when the lady received his letter and these 2 pieces of paper as she thought, she would stick the dollars (pieces of paper as she thought) on the wall. One day an old friend came to visit the lady. The friend was asking about her son. The lady told her that he sent a letter every week with 2 pieces of paper. I put them on the wall (at this stage there were hundreds of them). Her friend exclaimed you're so rich. The lady hadn't realised what the pieces of paper represented.
- Another story is told of a lady who had electricity installed in her home. Sometime after the electricity supply had been installed in her home the electricity supplier was somewhat surprised by the minimal usage of the power at the lady's disposal. When asked why that was the lady replied I only switch it on when it gets dark so I can see to light the candles I then switch it off again.
- As Christians we can be like either of these examples living in spiritual poverty when from within is
 the gifts required to change our perspective and build up the body of Christ.
- Every child of God has a supernatural heritage in them. Possessions of great and inestimable value. Such possessions are to enable every child of God to live in victory, deliverance and holiness.
- Let's strive to possess our possessions so that we might bring glory honour and praise to the King
 of kings and Lord of lords.
